- ARC therapist not hired yet. Ashley Fricke on maternity leave and SD23 short 3 ARC therapists.
- Activity Room has been renovated to utilise for Aboriginal Development

- Zen Dens in Activity Room provides calm space for quiet activity, 10-15 minutes
- Stations at the start of year before class assignment - rotations, assembly and matrix. Kids come up with outcomes and rules, teams to share ideas, assembly presentation. All student-based, well received. Teams to be used in several events throughout the year. Next one to come before Remembrance Day.
- LIF (Learning Improvement Funds) reduced to 1.25 hours; no more homework club. Instead there will be targeted Math and Reading help $3 \times$ a week. Data shows Gr 3 especially need reading help.
- Class Breakdown: K (20), K/1 (18), K/1 (20), 1 (22-max), 2/3 (20), 2/3 (21), 3/4 (20), 3/4 (20), 4/5 (23), 5/6 (20), 5/6 (22), 5/6 (21). K/1 Full only 2 spots left. Smaller Grade 6 classes because higher number of ministry designated students. Enrolment prediction: 246 (2016/17-239 students)
- Combined classes more effective in reducing ranges in capabilities between students
- New curriculum: move to increasingly personalised, deeper learning
- Changes to report cards for K-9 by March 2018 - increasing goal setting and self-assessment
- Planned changes to Mission Statement - collaborative effort between teachers, parents, students.
- Student Centred Learning - "What is my next step?"
- School Focus: Shared voice, socially responsible, leadership programs, collaboration, build relationships
- Fresh Grade: anticipated all teachers will be utilising this year
