3. New Business

Treasurer's Report

- Community Gaming Grant- approved \$4,780.00. Funds are used for class field trips- allotted \$15/student
- Grade 6 PAC bank account \$4000.00

PAC financial assistance to the grade 6's year end field trip. PAC matches up to \$1,500 of grade 6's fundraise for their trip. If they don't fundraise, the PAC provides no money.

- No votes against to continue this matching however parents wondering if this money can be used for other Grades, or other community enrichment
- Terrilyn to consult with teachers if they think money can be used for something other than field trip

School Funding Request - Raymer's Mini We Day for Grade 6

Previously PAC has provided funds for a select few students chosen to attend We Day in Vancouver-TOC cost \$400-700. In 2016, Grade 6 teachers and Principal decided to try something new and host a mini We Day at Raymer so that it is more inclusive for all grade 6 students. The funds requested covered the expense of food.

Requesting- \$450-550. Vote approved up to \$550

Halloween Dance - Friday, October 27th 6-7:30PM

\$5 per Person or \$10 per Family (4 people). Adult supervision required DJ Bowie Entertainment, prizes awarded for Best Family costume, most original, etc. Volunteers needed for sales, admission and judging.
